The Spirit of the Lord is on me ... Luke 4:18

The year of the Lord's favour proclaimed in Isaiah 61:1 is claimed here by Jesus in his home town of Nazareth. Jesus goes out into Galilee, healing, teaching, eating with disciples and expectant crowds.
